

Internet Safety



For Students

1. **NEVER give out personal information**
 - * Name, home address, phone number, school name should not be mentioned to people you do not know.
 - * Never send a picture of yourself without parental permission.
 - * Never give people your passwords (this includes friends!).

2. **Never e-mail someone who has made you feel uncomfortable**
 - * Tell your parents immediately.
 - * Block their e-mail address.

3. **Never meet someone or have them visit without permission**
 - * Tell your parents immediately if someone asks to meet you or wants to come to your house.

4. **Be careful what you post on the internet**
 - * Be careful of pictures and information you post on any social networking websites (ie: MySpace, Facebook).
 - * Beware of online predators. Remember people online might not be what they say they are. Just because they say they are an 11 year old girl, they could be an adult male.

5. **Beware of Cyber Bullying**
 - * Do not say anything online you would not want your parents to see.
 - * Report cyber bullying to your parents immediately. Report it to your principal, teacher or counselor if it is happening with someone at school.
