SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021

Dear Parent or Guardian.

Seymour Community Schools Health Services advise parents to **prepare** to have their students immunized for the 2020-2021 school year. According to Indiana Code 20-34-4 all students must be adequately immunized in order to attend school. We understand that immunizations have been delayed due to the COVID-19 Virus. Seymour Community Schools is partnering with the Jackson Health Department in offering immunization clinics at several schools this summer. Please note that these are immunizations required for school and not a vaccine for COVID-19.

Kindergarten students will need to be up to date on their immunizations before entering school on the first day.

It is very important that you register your kindergarten student online if you have not done so already. If you know of other parents of incoming kindergarten students please encourage them to register their students,

It is important to note that all students entering 6th grade in the 2020-2021 school year will need additional vaccines.

All students entering grades 9-12 in the fall will need additional vaccines.

The immunization clinics will be held from 12 PM - 6 PM and are scheduled as follows:

June 3rd Emerson and Cortland at Emerson Elementary School

June 9th at Jackson Elementary School

June 23rd at Redding Elementary School

June 30th at Brown Elementary School

July 7th and July 8th at Seymour High School

Please attend the vaccination clinic at the school which your child will be attending in the upcoming school year. All incoming 6th grade students will attend the clinic at the elementary school which they attended in 5th grade.

Please be advised that it is very important to attend these clinics if your child needs updated immunizations. You will receive a letter in the mail advising you of your child's needed immunizations and outlining the procedure to follow.
